RULES OF THE NHMC CLUBMANS AND AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIPS

You must be a member of NHMC prior to scoring points. The onus is on you to ensure that results are received by the Championship co-ordinator and are correctly totalled.

For the Autotest Championship all NHMC and any other non-NHMC Shell Oils League Autotest are eligible rounds. For the Clubmans Championship any NHMC competition event counts.

In both instances 3/4 of the eligible rounds will count.

Points scoring is as follows:-

	Start	20 points
Plus	Finish	10 points
Plus	FTD	30 points
Or	1st Class	25 points, to 5 points for 5th in class plus one point for every person beaten outside the top 5 in class. Where classes do not have 5 finishers then they may be amalgamated or points scored, reduced pro rata. The organiser of each event scores points equal to the highest points scoring competitor.
