Thank you for your entry, your individual details are as above.

The gates will be open for entry to the showground between 06.30 hours and 08.30 hours. No access will be available before or after these times.

Please arrive at Manby Showground via the B1200 and enter at Map Reference **113/381869**. Please do not attempt to enter at any other point.

From Louth follow the A157 signposted Mablethorpe until the roundabout, turn left onto the B1200 signposted Manby or follow the Louth bypass, Manby is signed from it.

Proceed to the service area shown on the diagram, unload trailers and go to the noise test. **Note** The noise test will be strict, the Landowner will not tolerate noisy cars. A scrutineering and documentation progress sheet is included, PLEASE bring it with you.

After a successful noise test, go to scrutineering and then documentation.

Petrol is not available on the venue.

Catering Facilities will be available in the service area from 0730 Hrs

We are asked by the landowner that you note the following points;

You must stop at the entrance gate and follow marshals instructions, do not exceed 15 MPH to the service area, please be as quiet as possible before and after the event (Penalty Exclusion). Any litter should be placed in the litter bins provided.

TIMING

As described in the ASR's, due time for MTC 1 will be written on your first time card, due time for subsequent arrival controls will be issued at the end of the previous stage (Card collect control). When the time card is handed in, the marshal will enter the due time at the next arrival control onto your next time card. Thus the order of starting the next stage will be the same as the finishing order of the previous stage.. This will ensure that a competitor who has caught a slower car, will start the next stage in front of that car.
