MSA to introduce second rally radio frequency

As recommended by the Scottish Motorsport Event Safety Review, the MSA is bringing online a second radio frequency for exclusive use by MSA Licensed Officials and safety personnel on stage rallies in Great Britain.

As the current radio safety frequency, MSA81 is an exclusive national radio communications resource. The addition of the second MSA81 frequency will allow for better management of rallies, particularly when there are stages running concurrently. Looks like the club will be possibly replacing our existing radio sets with the aid if a grant from the MSA.

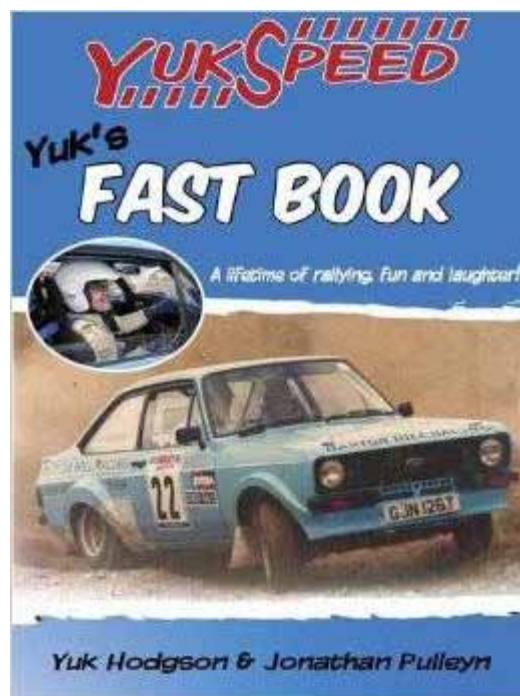
