**Instructions for Passage Control/MTC2**

Check sheets are different for the two rallies.

Time Cards are for competitor's use only – **DO NOT HANDLE TIME CARDS.**

The Juniors **do not need to stop at the PC after the first stage of each pair** (stages 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9). Please record the time at which they pass the control on your Check Sheet.

For the Juniors after the second stage of each pair of stages (stages 2, 4, 6, and 8) and for the adults after every stage from stage 1 to stage 8, you will be issuing their Due Time at the next stage arrival control. Rally HQ will tell you the time to give to the first competitor to arrive (separately for the Junior and adult rallies). Then there will be 2 cars on each minute. Your clock will be configured to issue the due arrival times and show them on the display clock.
